SCION WOOD for all varieties is \$4.00 per scion, with \$9.00 postage and handling for orders postmarked February 28th or before. Orders are shipped by U.S. Postal Service from late January to March, starting with southern states. Weather sometimes slows the collecting of scion wood, so please be patient.

Please list your scions on a piece of paper in alphabetical order. Also list a few alternative selections as we sometimes lose trees. We do not substitute, but if you would like us to do so, we will substitute with new and promising varieties. Sometimes we have to make the painful decision to send you a short or thin scion or none at all. Please let us know if you do not want short or thin scions.

We will accept orders after February 28 until March 15th provided they have a \$20 surcharge. This is a busy time of year for us ... thus the surcharge.

SUMMER BUDWOOD is available July & August at \$4.00 for each foot stick, plus \$10 for postage and handling. Please note the date you would like your budwood sent.

ABOUT SINGING TREE

Richard Fahey purchased 90 acres in 1963 when he was 21 with the intent to find ways that people could live self-sufficiently from the land. That led him to grow many kinds of plants for food, medicine, and home manufacture. Fruit and nut tree trials became a major part of his research so that today Singing Tree has hundreds of varieties of trees that are bearing. The knowledge gained is shared at regularly scheduled workshops. This year's Grafting Workshop will be Saturday, April 4th, 1-5pm (Cost: \$40), and Nut Grafting Workshop will be Saturday, May 2nd, 1-5pm (Cost: \$50). Send a long SASE for our full schedule.

Grafting Kits. For beginning grafters. All the essentials for a good start for a lifetime skill.

Regular Grafting Kit. Directions on how to graft, ten one year hardy seedling trees for apple rootstocks, five scions of the best apple varieties or five of your choice, a four ounce jar of grafting compound, ten metal labels, an ounce of mixed grafting rubbers, a Tina grafting knife and professional pruners. **Regular Kit: \$189/postpaid. Save \$25.50!**

Economy Grafting Kit. Includes everything in the Regular Kit except the Tina Knife and the professional pruners. **Economy Kit: \$80/postpaid. Save \$10.50!**

In addition you can send us a practice graft for evaluation and correction. Order by March 15.

Siberian Peach Trees. The hardiest peach in the world! Good where standard peaches are winter killed.

Siberian peaches are smaller than the standard peaches, and are about the same quality as supermarket peaches. The pink blossoms in the early spring make the tree an outstanding ornamental. Bears fruit in 2 or 3 years. A Minnesota costumer writes: "My Siberian peach trees have made it through three zone 3 winters!" Recommended for zone 4 and warmer zone 3 areas. 1 tree \$25; 3 trees \$60; 5 trees \$95. All postpaid.

Apple Trees. Trees grown from disease and insect resistant apple seed. Use them for good healthy root stocks, or let them fruit to discover new varieties. Order by March 15. **10 Trees for \$65/postpaid.**

Custom Grafted Apple Trees. For people who can't graft their own apple trees we offer two kinds of custom grafting on standard root stocks. Choose the varieties you want and we will graft them for you. Order by March 30.

1. One year old grafted whips. The root is two years old and the apple trees are ready to plant out. Order before March 15 for fall delivery. Custom grafted trees are \$25 each, plus \$20 postage and boxing east of the Mississippi and \$25 west of the Mississippi on any number of trees.

2. Bench Grafts. These little trees are grafted on one year old apple root stocks and mailed right away to you. They need to be put in a garden nursery row and the grafting rubbers need to be removed when vigorous growth gets underway. This is the least expensive way to get rare trees, but requires more of your attention. Order before March 15. **Bench grafts are \$10 each, plus \$12 postage on any quantity.**

GRAFTING SUPPLIES AND TREES

We offer the following grafting supplies and trees in small quantities for your convenience. *When you order them with scions or budwood you save postage costs.* If any of these items are ordered separately, except apple and Siberian peach trees, add \$10.00 postage and handling.

Write on Aluminum Tags. Always tag your graft with the variety name and the date. These 1"x 3" tags last for many years and are inscribed with a ball point pen.

10 Tags for \$3.50; 100 Tags for \$32.00

Tina Grafting Knife. This is the best grafting knife made. Once you have used it you will use no other.

Made in Germany of high carbon steel with walnut handle. It makes clean cuts twice as fast. It stays sharp longer, yet it is quicker to sharpen. Right handed only. Jim Darling in N.Y. writes, "The Tina knife worked like a charm. It really improved my grafting rate." **\$51 each.**

Folding Grafting & Budding Knife. A high quality two bladed stainless steel knife made by Victorinox, the Swiss Army knife company. A folding knife has the advantage of being able to be kept in your pocket. Best for hobbyists, who graft a few trees each season. I use mine when I go to town to graft a tree or two for friends. The red, high impact plastic handles help you find it easily.

Two Bladed Grafting & Budding Knife: \$35

Natural Sharpening Stone. The stone I use for all my knife sharpening is a native stone in our area. One hundred years ago our township was a center for natural grind stones. When I am exploring out in the woods or along a creek, I occasionally find a perfectly flat, round, smooth stone. The rounded palm size stones make perfect pocket whet stones that don't wear holes in your pocket like square stones do. These stones are used with water. [Don't use oil to sharpen grafting knives. Oil on a knife can inhibit the graft from healing.] Stones will last a lifetime. Perfectly flat on one side, and relatively flat on the other side. **Natural Pocket Sharpening Stone: \$12.00**

Grafting Rubbers. For whip and whip and tongue grafts. If you have never used grafting rubbers send a SASE and \$1 for literature on how to use them. They can greatly improve your grafting.

Thin: For small diameter scions: **1 oz. [about 110 rubbers] \$4.00**

Medium: For most fruits: **1 oz. [about 65 rubbers] \$4.00**

Thick: For pencil thick scions and larger. For most nuts: **1 oz. [about 32 rubbers] \$4.00**

Mix of all sizes. **1oz. \$4.00**
